

AUTHORS PREPARING PAPERS FOR THE JOURNAL EKONOMIKA SHOULD BE AWARE THAT

The journal Ekonomika (established and published by Vilnius University) is designated as a scientific publication for the dissemination of doctoral dissertations and works of habilitation (Science and Studies Department to the Ministry of Education and Science order 01 05 1998 No. 13, confirmed by the Lithuanian Science Council 10 November 1997 decision No. 111-39).

The criteria for evaluating papers (in order of importance)

1. The presentation of research results whose originality and scientific value can be considered, in Lithuania and abroad, a contribution to economic science.

2. Presentation of original explanations and solutions to the problems of economic theory and methodology under investigation.

3. Examination and evaluation of the condition and development of the economy, and sectors of the economy and strategies of separate firms in domestic and foreign markets.

4. The proposed solutions of the problems of economic and social development, or financial, accounting, statistical and information infrastructure analysed.

5. Presentation of scientific interpretation and evaluation of the problems of economic management analysed of interest not only to Lithuanian but also to foreign scientists and specialists.

6. Investigation of practical problems of the Lithuanian economy, and their resolution.

Note: Reviews and other informative material can be submitted at the end of each package of works.

Requirements concerning the style of papers

1. At the start of the paper in separate paragraphs the author must give the title, author's name, scientific qualification and academic title, workplace (institution, branch, address, telephone, fax, and email address if possible). The author must submit two hard copies of the paper and one copy on disk. The text must be printed on one side of A4 format paper with 1.5 interval line spacing (since this is necessary for marking comments). The text on disk must be prepared on the Word for Windows (preferably Word'97 or Word'2000) text editor, in the *Times New Roman* font.

2. The paper must contain the necessary parts of a scientific paper – research aims described at the beginning, highlighting the research objective, method (for theoretical work the problems and the new arguments used in their solution); and at the end the paper must present research results, conclusions and the list of literature.

3. Papers in Lithuanian must have a complete summary in one of the basic international scientific languages (English, German, French). If the paper is written in one of these basic languages

of world science there must be a complete summary in Lithuanian.

4. Separately indicate how complete is the research and who recommended to publish the paper in the journal *Ekonomika*, for example if the recommendation came from your

department submit the department's recommendation (it is not necessary to submit the review of the paper). Also indicate the paper's author's telephone and email, through which it is possible to directly cooperate with the authors.
